- **TAMA membership has increased to 35 members. This represents a .94% increase in our membership funding**

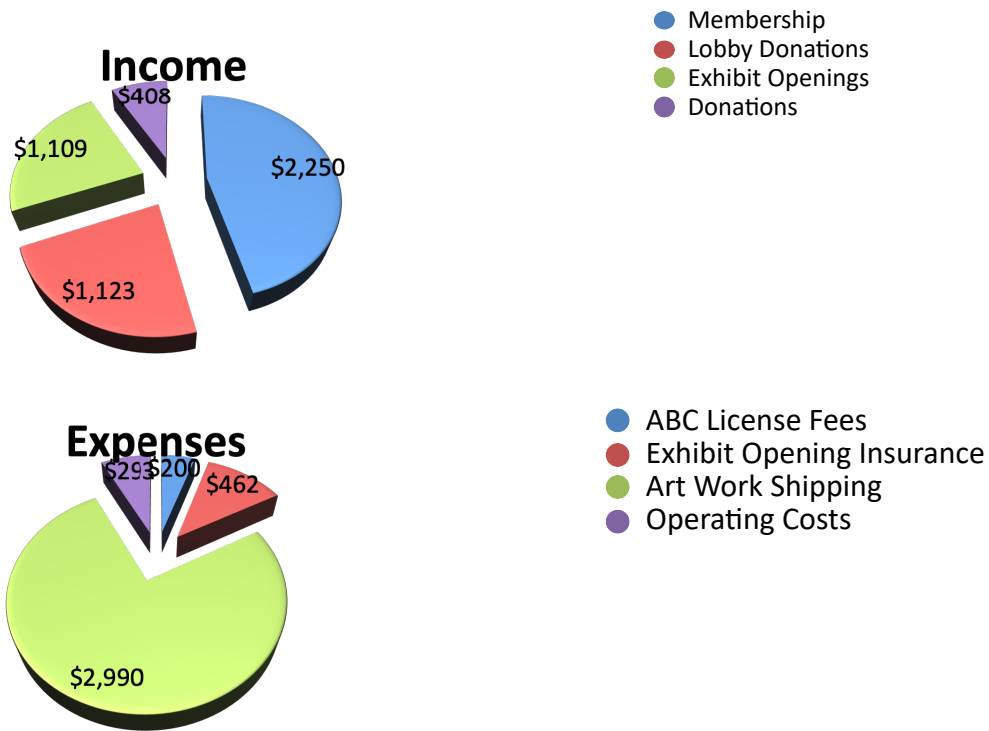
### **Goals for 2020-21**

**We are pleased to announce that our lobby donations increased substantially this year by 961%. Lobby donations in 2018-19 were \$212 and increased to \$2250 in 2019-20.**

**This is the first year that TAMA collected and managed the Lobby Donation Box.**

**Donations generated by exhibit opening fundraisers, unfortunately, decreased by 22%.**

**This is likely a result of TAM closing in March due to the Covid-19 safety precautions.**

**This closure eliminated spring and summer opening exhibits.**
