Jeannine thanked the Board members for their assistance during the TAMA Appreciation Event and General Membership Meeting on July 21, 2023.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Opening Reception for the fall exhibitions will take place on October 7, 2023 from 6 - 9 p.m. at the museum. Denielle will obtain the ABC License and will be present to pour for this event. She will arrange for the necessary supplies for the event as well.

The TAMA Member and Docent Walkthrough is on October 6, 2023 at the museum. An email will be sent to all members with a reminder.

Tryst/Nomad II will be held at Del Amo Crossing from Friday, October 27th through Sunday, October 29th from 12 - 5 p.m. with a VIP reception for TAMA Members and invited guests from 4 - 6 p.m. on Friday October 27th. Extensive discussion regarding the serving of food and alcohol with limited volunteers. It was decided to apply for a temporary Seller's Permit through the State of California and to increase the charge for a glass of wine to \$7 per with the understanding there will be a 6% sales tax assessment for any alcohol sold. There is no tax on food. Suggested snack foods vs. foods needing to be kept a a certain temperature.

Odyssey Art Acquisition Event will be held in conjunction with Tryst/Nomad II based on volunteer availability. Recommended a visit to the venue the week prior to establish how much effort will be required to set up prior to the sale. Need to check with Max/ TAM re: securing artwork and unsold alcohol/snacks after the event closes each day. Jeannine will check with Monica to see if the insurance policy covering TAM at the event will also cover TAMA activities there. She will also send an email out to solicit volunteers for the event; Max has agreed to a 50% (\$50) off a piece of artwork as a thank you for volunteering. The Board agreed this would apply to only the first piece selected with all subsequent purchases being full price (\$100). Additionally volunteers will be asked to donate alcohol and snacks. Both Denielle and Patrice will explore the 'taco stand' options for the event to provide food for sale to artists and attendees.

Upcoming TAMA TALKS episodes featuring ¿Wild? Artist Dodd Holdsapple and Greece AIR Steven Wolkoff will be scheduled at the completion of their projects.
